Dose Management

What is Dose Management?

It's a quality and safety program that may make your medication plan easier to follow. It lowers the number of tablets you have to take each day.

For example, if you take two 75 mg tablets each day, you would take one 150 mg tablet instead. A single 150 mg tablet of a medication often costs less than two 75 mg tablets. It may also make it easier for you to follow your medication plan.

We base the program on U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and manufacturer dosing guidelines, medical literature, safety, accepted medical practice, appropriate use and benefit design.

Dose Management only affects the amount of medication your benefit plan covers. You and your doctor should make the final decision about the medication that is right for you.

What Happens at the Pharmacy?

The pharmacist enters your prescription information into the computer system. If your medicine has a dose limit, the pharmacist will fill your prescription as long as it does not exceed the limit. If your prescription exceeds the limit, you have two choices:

- With your approval, your pharmacist can change your prescription to the doses your plan covers. Or, the pharmacist can work with your doctor to change your doses.
- 2. You can pay full price for your original prescription.

Which Medications are Included?

We post the most recently updated list of medications on our website. The program includes drugs that have been approved by the FDA for once-a-day doses and have different strengths available at similar costs.

See the drugs and the daily dose limits below. Check your benefit information to determine if dose management applies to you. If dose management applies to you and if you are taking multiple daily doses of medications with limits, talk to your doctor or pharmacist about the higher strengths.
